



FACT SHEET

As of May 2022, construction is underway on North Florida Innovation Labs: a state-of-the-art, 40,000 sqft hard science, high tech business incubator that is the first of its kind in the North Florida region.

Located in Innovation Park, the facility will offer:

- 30+ wet and dry labs
- Tissue and bio-culture room
- Fabrication and prototype development spaces
- 20+ offices
- Multiple co-working spaces and conference rooms

The facility is designed to support over 100 early stage and growing tech companies in high priority targeted industries. It will sustain over 600 full time, permanent, high-quality jobs in the region based on IMPLAN modeling.

The new facility will be located just steps away from some of the world's leading research institutions including the National High Magnetic Field Laboratory, the FSU High Performance Materials Institute, the Florida Center for Advanced Power Systems, and many more specialized facilities. The FAMU-FSU College of Engineering and the Tallahassee International Airport are within a few miles' radius, as are the campuses of FSU, FAMU, and TCC.
